

DROP FOOD OFF AT CHURCH

This Sunday is the Sunday of the month we typically collect your food for St. Vincent DePaul. You can still drop food off in the large grey tote just outside the church doors under the portico on the west side of the building.

SVDP has shared with us that they are giving out more food than ever! So,,. contact the neighbors on your street by email or taping notes on their door. The note should explain that you are collecting food on behalf of your church, Pleasant Grove Community Church, to supply the Food Bank. ask them to donate food from their pantry or purchased when they go to the store (non-perishable only). Ask them to put it out by their front door and call you and you will come pick it up (or they can leave it at your front door).

When you have a load ready, call the church office at 916-771-4447 and we will come by and pick it up from your porch. Be sure to leave a "Thank You" note for those who have donated.

This is a simple way for you and your neighbors to do something meaningful and connect your neighbors to our church.

SHOW GRATITUDE TO OUR FIRST RESPONDERS
